Inaugural Temasek Cares Bursary Awards for ITE Students

First batch of 30 needy ITE students to receive \$1,000 each this year

More ITE students will be benefitting from bursary awards, thanks to a fresh donation of S\$30,000 in funds from Temasek Cares, a non-profit philanthropic organisation launched by Temasek Holdings in June 2009. The Temasek Cares Bursary Awards aim to encourage promising ITE students from low-income families to progress and excel in their studies.

2 The inaugural bursary awards will benefit ITE students, who are Singapore citizens, with gross monthly household per capita income of more than \$500 but less than or equal to \$600. There are currently more than 600 of such students in ITE. Some of these students now support themselves through part-time work. The bursary awards are expected to relieve the students of their financial burdens, and allow them to stay focused on their studies, so as to complete their courses successfully.

3 Currently, ITE has bursaries for students from families with a gross monthly household per capita income of up to \$500. The Temasek Cares Bursary Awards increases the qualifying criteria of per capita income ceiling to \$600, and reaches out to students who have fared well in their ITE courses.

More to Benefit in the Coming Years

4 Mr Richard R Magnus, Board Chairman, Temasek Cares, who is also the Chairman of the Casino Regulatory Authority, will present the bursary awards to the pioneer batch of 30 ITE students, in a Ceremony to be at held on **Wed 21 October 2009**. The Ceremony will take place at the **Function Hall, Level 3, ITE College East, Simei Avenue.**

5 Mr Richard R Magnus said: “Temasek Cares’ support of the bursary awards is closely aligned to our aim of building students for life. I am glad that we are partnering ITE to nurture young people through education and training for employability skills. This is Temasek Cares’ first programme and we hope to provide more bursary awards in the coming years that serve as a catalyst in helping promising students to succeed and excel in their studies.”

6 Said Mr Bruce Poh, Director & CEO, ITE: “On behalf of ITE, I would like to thank Temasek Cares for its philanthropic gestures towards ITE students. The Temasek Cares Bursary will certainly make a difference to motivated and needy ITE students each year.”

7 In addition to good academic performance, the recipients of the Temasek Cares Bursary Awards must possess good character and sound values, and have been identified as potential leaders who can contribute to society.
